Please set out your recyclables by 6:00 a.m.

WHAT IS SINGLE-SORT RECYCLING?
A SIMPLE EASY WAY TO TAKE CARE OF YOUR RECYCLABLES. COMBINE ALL RECYCLABLES TOGETHER. NO NEED TO SORT.

How To Recycle

Simply place all your recyclables **LOOSELY** into the recycle bin or cart, and place on the opposite side of the driveway from your trash cart. **Do Not Bag Recyclables.**

What Should **NOT** be Recycled?

Paper Plates • Cups • Napkins • Tissue • Wrapping Paper • Boxes With Food (Produce, Deli or Black Take Out Containers) • Window Glass • Ceramics • Pottery • Dishware • Cookware • Mirrors • Light Bulbs • Styrofoam • Vinyl Siding • Needles

Single-Sort



All types of paper and cardboard can be mixed together for collection with all items including containers, plastics, household scrap metal-silverware, pots and pans, and any metal that fits in cart.

Paper



Mixed Paper- Junk Mail, Phone Books, Magazines, Cardboard

Newspaper (including inserts); Shredded Paper (placed in a sealed paper bag); Egg Cartons; Snack and Cereal Boxes; Frozen Food Boxes, Pop, Beer and *Pizza Boxes.

Containers



Glass, Jars, and Bottles (all colors); Tin and Aluminum Cans; *Milk Cartons and Juice Boxes*; Aerosol Cans

Plastics



*Plastic with recycling symbols #1 through #7, (except #6 Styrofoam) Beverage Containers, Yogurt Containers, Plastic Toys, Drained Motor Oil Bottles, Flower and Shrub Containers, Landscape Edging, Laundry Basket, *Kitty Litter Pails - 5 Gal Pails, Clear Clamshell (clear plastic packaging.)*



*Retail Plastic Bags (consolidated in one bag please)
