RE: Recycling Market increases

As you may already be aware, recycling markets have experienced dramatic changes in values of commodities throughout the country. The reports you have read in the papers or heard on the local and national news have impacted the Twin Cities. China no longer accepts the recycling that we were exporting to their Country. Our processors are having to find other means to recycle the paper, plastic and glass which is now costing us to recycle.

We have included several hyperlinks on our website which will educate you of the changing markets and how they are impacting recycling rates.

We have experienced another round of rate adjustments in recycling due to the drastic change in commodity values. Our markets have notified us (see letter below). As a result of this increase rates have now increase 75% from last year.

As a part of providing quality service to our customers, it is important that we monitor our costs within our industry. We will be adjusting your "Commodity Adjustment Fee" to off-set our recycling increase. The trash portion of your rate will not be affected.
